

YOUR NEXT STEPS

1. Access your myULM account.

Your myULM account is your digital hub with important links, including your new Warhawk email account. ULM will send all housing, scholarship, and registration updates to your Warhawk email address. Follow instructions at ulm.edu/admissions/logins.

2. Accept your Academic Scholarship.

If you're offered a ULM Academic Scholarship, remember to view and accept your scholarship offer at webservices.ulm. edu/sats. To view other scholarship opportunities at ULM, visit ulm.edu/scholarships.

3. Schedule a campus visit.

Let us show you around your new home! A personalized, oneon-one campus tour is the best way to learn about academic programs, student life, and the Warhawk Way. Schedule your tour at ulm.edu/visit.

4. Upload your immunization records.

Visit ulm.edu/immunization for full details regarding uploading your vaccination records or waiver.

5. Set up your LOSFA student hub.

Louisiana students applying for TOPS must create a LOSFA account at mylosfa.la.gov. Your LOSFA account needs to have your most recent ACT score and final high school transcript.

6. File your FAFSA.

Visit studentaid.gov to fill out your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). ULM's school code is 002020. Any student wishing to apply for Federal Financial Aid or a ULM campus job must fill out the FAFSA. All Louisiana students who want to apply for TOPS are also required to complete the FAFSA.

7. Apply for housing.

Get the full Warhawk experience by living on campus. There are multiple housing options at various price points, from traditional suites to single-person apartments. Housing applications open January 1 and we recommend you apply as soon as possible at ulm.edu/reslife or call 318.342.5240.

8. Register for PREP.

PREP is an exciting, two-day, summer orientation for incoming freshmen. You'll register for classes, meet your first college friends, and learn all there is to be a Warhawk! Be on the lookout for PREP registration in the spring at ulm.edu/prep. Questions? Call 318.342.7315 or email prep@ulm.edu.

9. Check your Admissions Account.

Within your Admissions Account, make sure that your official high school transcript is marked as "received" after graduation. If you have earned Dual Enrollment credit, check for those transcripts to be "received" as well. Official transcripts can be emailed to docman@ulm.edu.
